# HIV Alliance Overview

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- **Care for over 1,200 people living with HIV in 13 Counties**
- **Peers Programs in Lane, Douglas, Coos, Josephine, Jackson, Marion**
- **HIV, HCV, & Syphilis Testing in Lane, Marion, Douglas, Curry, Josephine and Coos County**
- **Student Education to over 5,500 youth in Lane, Marion, Douglas Counties**
- **Outreach to over 3,000 high risk community members**
- **Syringe Exchange in Lane, Marion, Washington, Douglas, Coos, Curry, and Josephine Counties**

# Harm Reduction at the HIV Alliance

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- Naloxone resources for clients, agency, and community members.
- One for one syringe exchange and new equipment to protect against HIV and HCV
- Testing for HIV ,HCV, and Syphilis.
- Fentanyl test strips.
- Resources for treatment, medical, and safer injection resources.
- Each clients is asked for testing, treatment access, and other barriers of need.
- Peers are involved in four county's for connection to care.

# Testing at the HIV Alliance

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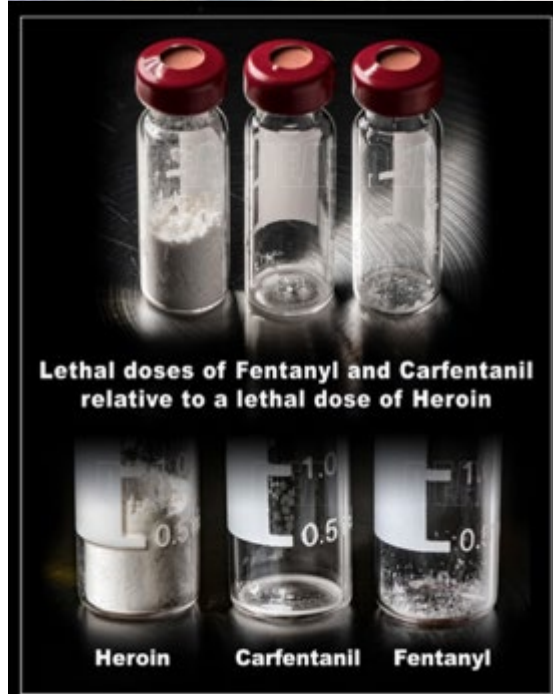
- HIV
  - Reactive first test run a second
  - Connection to care team
  - Test last year 729, reactive 3
- HCV
  - Reactive test
  - Immediate connection to PATHS
  - Test last year 691, reactive 64
- Syphilis.
  - Immediate connection to PATHS and Peers for access to care
  - Test last year 555, reactive 14

# Syringe Exchange services at the HIV Alliance

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- NEX
  - Coos 166 Clients 26,070 syringes
  - Curry 214 Clients 16230 syringes
  - Josephine 992 Clients 105,489 syringes
  - Douglas 2,134 Clients 257,111 syringes
- Naloxone
  - Coos 364 clients, 1,040 doses, 26 reversals
  - Curry 178 clients, 978 doses, 21 reversals
  - Josephine 432 clients, 1,695 doses, 122 reversals
  - Douglas 1,622 clients, 5,786 doses, 306 reversals
